A NEW SPECIES OF THE GENUS ASTRAGALUS L. SECT. HYMENOSTEGIS FROM KURDISTAN, IRAN

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Maassoumi, A. A. & Maroofi, H. 2006 08 01: A new species of the genus *Astragalus* L. sect. *Hymenostegis* from Kurdistan, Iran. *–Iran. Journ. Bot. 12 (1): 92-93*. Tehran.

Astragalus montis-nacarouzii is described from the sect. Hymenostegis. It has been collected from Kurdistan province, Kuhe Nacarouz where it has been under collection. The new species is related to A. glumaceus and A. pediculariformis.

علی اصغر معصومی و حسین معروفی گونه جدیدی از جنس Astragalus در کردستان

گونه جدید A. montis-nacarouzii Maassoumi & Maroofi بعنوان گونه جدید متعلق به بخش Hymenostegis از کردستان، کوه نکروز شرح داده می شود. گونه جدید از منطقهای معرفی می گردد که تاکنون جمع آوری چندانی صورت نگرفته است و این گونه در بسیاری از صفات با گونه های خویشاوند خود چون A. glumaceus Boiss. و گرفته است و این گونه در بسیاری از صفات با گونه دارد.

Introduction

Based on new collection during the few last years from Kurdistan province, a new species *A. montis-nacarouzii* from sect. *Hymenostegis* is described. The new species is compared with the nearest related e.g. *A. glumaceus* Boiss. and *A. pediculariformis* Maassoumi.

Astragalus montis-nacarouzii Maassoumi & Maroofi, sp. nov.

Similis A. glumaceis Boiss. sed differt foliolis anguste ellipticis c. 3-4 mm latis (nec 3-12 mm), pilis in part vegetatio brevissimis et patentibus (nec longissimis et subappressis); bracteis ovatis, c. 14 mm latis, glabrescentibus (nec 3-9 mm latis, glabris); calycis breviter inflatis, c. 4 mm latis (nec 8-16 mm). Differt ab A. pediculariformis Maassoumi, bracteis ovatis c. 14 mm latis (nec 3-6 mm); calycis pilis longis obtectis (nec longis et brevissimis immixitis).

Plant suffruticose, densely caespitose, c. 25-30 cm tall, spiny. Stem c. 15 cm long, thick and lignose at the base, branched, with dark brown to blackish bark, often covered with remnants of old petioles, part of current

year 1-3 cm long, often branched, covered by stipules, rather densely covered with spreading hairs. Stipules chartaceous, whitish to pale yellowish, c. 18-20 mm long, at the base adnate to the petiole c. 10 mm, vaginate, connate behind the stem for 8 mm, the free portion narrowly triangular, acuminate, very sparsely hairy, at the margin remotely ciliate with the hairs c. 0.4-0.6 mm. Leaves 6-7 cm long; petiole 2-3.5 cm long, rather often rigid, c. 1 mm thick, densely covered with spreading different sized hairs, c. 0.4-0.6 mm long. Leaflets 6-7 pairs, narrowly elliptic, acuminate, c. 10-15 mm long and 3-4 mm wide, with a pungent yellowish cusp c. 1 mm long, both sides sparsely covered with spreading hairs c. 0.3-1 mm long. Peduncle c. 4-6 cm long, densely covered with spreading hairs c. 0.3-1 mm long. Racemes ovoid to cylindrical, c. 2-5 cm long and 2.5-3 cm in diameter, many flowered. Bracts persistent, thickly membranous, pale brown to purplish, c. 17 mm long and 14 mm wide, widely ovate-acuminate, sparsely hairy, very soon glabrous, remotely ciliate at the margin with hairs up to 1 mm long. Calyx at the beginning tubular, later shortly inflated, c. 15 mm long and 4 mm wide, mostly with purplish teeth, rather densely covered with ascending hairs 2-2.5 mm long, inner side glabrous; teeth subulate, c. 8 mm long, inner side sparsely hairy. Corolla purplish. Standard 20 mm long; limb c. 8 mm long, oblong-panduriform, constricted bellow the middle, shortly obtusely auriculate-hastate at the base, with broadly cuneate claw. Wings c. 19 mm long; limb narrowly oblong at the apex, obtuse, 8.5 mm long and 2.5 mm wide; auricle very short; claw c 11 mm long. Keel c. 15 mm long; limb obliquely obovate, obtuse at apex, c. 6 mm long and 3 mm wide; claw c. 10 mm long. Ovary sessile, densely hairy; style glabrous at the base. Legumes sessile (immature), 2.5 mm long and 1.5 mm wide, densely appressed hairy.
